

Introductions to the International Symposium on Cashmere Identification Technologies (ISCIT)

International Symposium on Cashmere Identification Technologies (ISCIT) is organized by both China Wool Textile Association (CWTA) and Strategic Alliance for Technological Innovation in Cashmere Industry (SATICI). Held every two years, the symposium highlights innovations and applications of new technologies on cashmere and other specialist animal hair testing techniques. It will be a rare opportunity for the symposium speakers and participants to share their expertise and good practices with your supply chain partners as well as a good opportunity to seek opportunities for collaborations.

The participants of the symposium include cashmere testing laboratories, commercial testing houses and associated industrial organizations, universities, colleges and research institutions, and companies undertaking animal fiber related business in the textile supply chain including cashmere and other animal fiber farming, fiber trading, early stage processing, manufacturing and retailing.

The conference is supported by the Inner Mongolia local government, China National Textile & Apparel Council (CNTAC), Cashmere and Camel Hair Manufacturers Institute (CCMI), International Cooperation Committee of Animal Welfare (ICCAW) and many important cashmere companies and universities.

China Wool Textile Association(CWTA)

CWTA was established in 1995 and is a national industry organization representing Chinese wool textile industry. With more than 500 industrial members ranging from wool fiber processing to garment making, CWTA supports its members in strategic planning, regional industry development, building branding strategy, technical-economic analysis, and sustainable growth. CWTA has been one of the national committee members in the International Wool Textile Organization (IWTO), representing Chinese wool textile industry, since March 1998.

Strategic Alliance for Technological Innovation in Cashmere Industry (SATICI)

SATICI aggregates the innovative resources of key enterprises, universities, research institutions and industry associations in the cashmere industry chain (cashmere goat breeding and cashmere product processing) and forms a cooperative organization with 47 members. Its mission is to establish and improve the industrial chain, sort out and improve industry standards, solve the bottleneck projects in the cashmere field, and lay a solid foundation for the internationalization of China's cashmere industry.
